Satoshi Kaneko graduated from the National Defense Medical College in 1990, received his M.P.H. from the Harvard School of Public Health in 1997 and his Ph.D. from the University of Occupational and Environmental Health, Japan in 2001.

He then became a section head at the National Cancer Center, Tokyo.

He has been a professor at the Kenya Research Station of the Institute of Tropical Medicine, Nagasaki University since October 2005, a professor in the Department of Epidemiology at the same institute since 2008, and a senior professor in the Department of Epidemiology since July 2016.

He has also been director of the Kenya Research Station since 2018, vice dean of the Institute of Tropical Medicine since April 2022, and executive advisor to the president (in charge of overseas research centers) since April 2023.

He specializes in epidemiology and public health. He received the Takemi Incentive Award in 2016.
